# Clubs & Groups

## 3-5 ALIVE

3-5 Alive is an after school Kids Club, where children of all different backgrounds come together to make new friends and learn about our great God.

**Who:** School Year 3 to 5  
(Year 2's are invited from Term 3)

**When:** 6:15pm - 7:45pm Fridays  
**Where:** 114 Lovell Rd

It's a 1.5 hour program including activities such as games, crafts, singing, off site events (i.e. mini golf, ice skating), bible stories and supper.

## PLAYCENTRE

**Who:** Parents & Toddlers  
(under 5's)  
**When:** 10am - 12pm Tuesdays  
**Where:** 100 Balaclava Rd

Playcentre is a mid-morning group where parents and their toddlers (under 5 year olds) can come together for mutual support and social interaction.

Children are encouraged to play with others, listen to bible stories and have fun! There is even a chance for the parents to share a quiet cuppa!



Zest for life is a Kids Holiday Club for children in school years 2-6, running each year in the 2nd week of the April School Holidays.

## LEGO LEAGUE

Lego League is an 10 week competition (mid September to early December) where teams of up to 10 kids (aged 9-14) compete to build an autonomous LEGO® Robot to complete predetermined missions. Teams solve real world technology problems in a fun, safe and supportive environment.

**When:** Sep - Dec, Weeknights

Macquarie Anglican Church is currently host to 3 LEGO League teams (with the intention of hosting more!), and your child is invited to join! Teams will meet for 2 hours weekly, to research and design their robot, hear a bit about Jesus, eat some food and have a great time! Given the Technology involved, is a weekly cost to cover purchase of materials (approx \$8/wk).

## SUNDAY SCHOOLS

**Who:** School Year K to 5  
**When:** 9:45am, 11am, 5pm Sundays  
**Where:** 9:45am @ 100 Balaclava Rd  
11am & 5pm @ 114 Lovell Rd

We have three weekly Sunday Schools that meet during the 9:45am, 11am and 5pm Church Services. All are English speaking.

At 9:45am and 5pm, the children begin in church where there is a Kids Talk and Song, after which they

move out to various age appropriate sunday school groups. Each group includes games, crafts, and Bible Teaching in a fun and relaxed environment.



## Schools

Macquarie Anglican Church is intimately involved in the local schools. We coordinate and teach **Anglican Scripture** at the three local primary schools, these being: **Denistone East Public School, Eastwood Heights Public School, Kent Rd Public School.**

In addition to weekly scripture classes, we are also involved in each school's Easter & Christmas celebrations. Is your child enrolled at one of these schools? Why not enroll your child in Anglican Scripture? Simply write a letter to the school requesting this.

## Preschools

Macquarie Anglican Church hosts two preschools within our premises - **St George's Preschool, and St Dunstan's Preschool.** Whilst we do not run these facilities, we are intimately involved in their community life through management boards, working bees and picnics.

Each preschool is visited regularly by our Children's Minister (Tim Adams) who sings songs, tells bible stories, and sometimes brings his furry puppet friends! The children eagerly anticipate these visits!
