Craft Ideas

1. Feet that Follow Jesus

Just as Simon Peter followed Jesus, we can too! In this activity we get to think about what it looks like to follow Jesus.

You will need:

- Paper or cardboard
- Pencils/textas/pens/crayons
- Scissors

Instructions:

- 1. Trace your foot on the paper/cardboard
- 2. Write or draw what it looks like to follow Jesus (e.g. loving others, being kind, serving at church, obeying parents, reading Bible, praying etc)
- 3. Cut the foot out (see picture below as example)

2. Fish

Peter was a fisherman. So for this craft you can fish too!


You will need:

- Paper clips
- Bible verse fish cut-outs (attached below)
- String
- A stick

Instructions:

- 1. Colour in and cut out the bible verse fish.
- 2. Attach a paperclip to each fish, leaving a loop at the end.
- 3. Bend a paperclip into a hook shape.
- **4.** Tie one end of the string to the paper clip hook.
- **5.** Tie the other end to the stick.
- **6.** Have fun fishing for the Bible verse and putting it in order! Have a go at the Fishing Friends game.





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1. Fishing Friends

Use this game to help you learn a Bible verse! "Come, follow me," Jesus said, "and I will send you out to fish for people."

Matthew 4:19

You will need:

- Fishing rod
- Bible verse fish
- Timer

Instructions:

- 1. Set out the fish evenly spread on the floor (or all around the room if you feel adventurous).
- 2. Time how long it takes to catch all the fish and put the verse together!

2. Follow Me

Jesus told his disciples to "come follow me." So in this game, see if you can follow your friends.

Instructions:

- 1. Have one person make up an action
- 2. Everyone else copy the action
- 3. Make up another action
- 4. Everyone else does the first action and the new action.
- 5. Keep adding actions and see how many everyone can follow before they forget!
